FACT SHEET

The ARC-Brevard, Inc. multi-corporate community provides a spectrum of services to individuals with developmental disabilities and their families designed to assist them to maximize their individual potential and achieve the highest level of independence.

This mission is accomplished through an organizational structure that provides the following major programs for individuals with developmental disabilities.

Social Services

The ARC Social Services program provides an overlay service to all divisions consisting of Intake and Referral, Support Plan Coordination, Program Plan Development and Tracking, parental resource and point of contact of information dissemination.

Personal & Family Support Services

(Serves over 1200* Children, Adults, and Families)

Chore Services: Heavy household chores, such as washing floors, cleaning carpets or moving heavy furniture.

Companion Services: One-on-one, non-medical care, supervision and socialization activities in your own home or in a variety of community locations.

Homemaker Services: General household activities such as meal preparation, laundry, vacuuming and routine household cleaning tasks.

In-home Support Services: Provides for someone to live in the individual's home, sharing expenses and providing the support services needed. Services range from assisting with bathing and eating, to provision of opportunities for participation in the life of the community.

Respite Services: This program provides relief from the day to day challenges of caring for someone with special needs, which lessens the risk of abuse, neglect, or divorce. Companion level care is offered in the home.

Personal Care Assistance Service: Assistance with eating, bathing, dressing, personal hygiene and daily living activities that are essential to the health and welfare of the individual.

Family Resource Center: A parent run, multifaceted program for families of children with any type of special need (developmental, physical or emotional).

Family Liaison: Promotes the social, emotional and academic growth of exceptional students and their families by facilitating positive pro-active communication between the families and educators.

Program Services
(Serves over 120* Adults)

ENRICH: ENRICH is a specialized program serving individuals who cannot function in a traditional work program due to severe functional deficits, physical and or medical needs.

Community-based Training: Mobile crews offer paid skill development opportunities in community settings allowing individuals with developmental disabilities an opportunity to interact in the community while still benefiting from agency supervision and training.

ARC's crews currently provide commercially competitive lawn care, parking lot cleaning, and janitorial services for local governmental agencies, as well as for private businesses. The agency also provides all recycling services for Patrick Air Force Base and Cape Canaveral Air Force Station including paper, cardboard, aluminum cans, metals, oil and even base housing curbside recycling pickup through NISH (National Industries for the Severely Handicapped).

Facility-based Training: Facility-based skill development services are provided at each of ARC's facility locations. By subcontracting with area businesses for assembly, packaging, sorting and bulk mailing services, ARC can provide the individuals served with simulated work settings, supervision and training.

Residential Services
(Serves over 100* Adults)

Group Home: ARC-Brevard, Inc. provides housing and training in community living skills to 51 adults in four group home facilities in Central, South, and North Brevard. Residents participate in the daily functions of each home, doing tasks within their ability and with staff training and supervision. The goal is to refine the skills of the residents to develop to their fullest potential in terms of community living options.

Group Home Overnight Respite: This program allows individuals to receive 24 hour care and supervision in a group home setting in order to provide relief to full time caregivers and to provide socialization and increased independence to individuals.

Supported Living: The goal of ARC's Supported Living Program is to assist and support individuals in community living in their own apartment or house. This is accomplished through home and roommate selection, functional skill training and ongoing support.

Funding

Funding Sources: Federal Medicaid Waiver funds, Housing and Urban Development funds, Florida Department of Children and Families funds, United Way of Brevard County, Brevard County School Board, State Medicaid, various grants, private contributions, fund-raising events, ARC Memberships, and revenues generated from ARC products and services.

Fund Raising Events: Each year ARC is challenged to raise additional funds for expenses not covered through traditional funding sources. The two major events are:

- Bikes & Blues with Mickey Jones 1st weekend of April
- Cal Dixon Celebrity Offshore Fishing Classic 3rd weekend of May

***Distribution of Individuals/Families Served Per Division:**

ARC-Brevard served a total of 1,360 individuals and their families as of December, 2003; 72 of these individuals received services from more than one division (duplicated).
